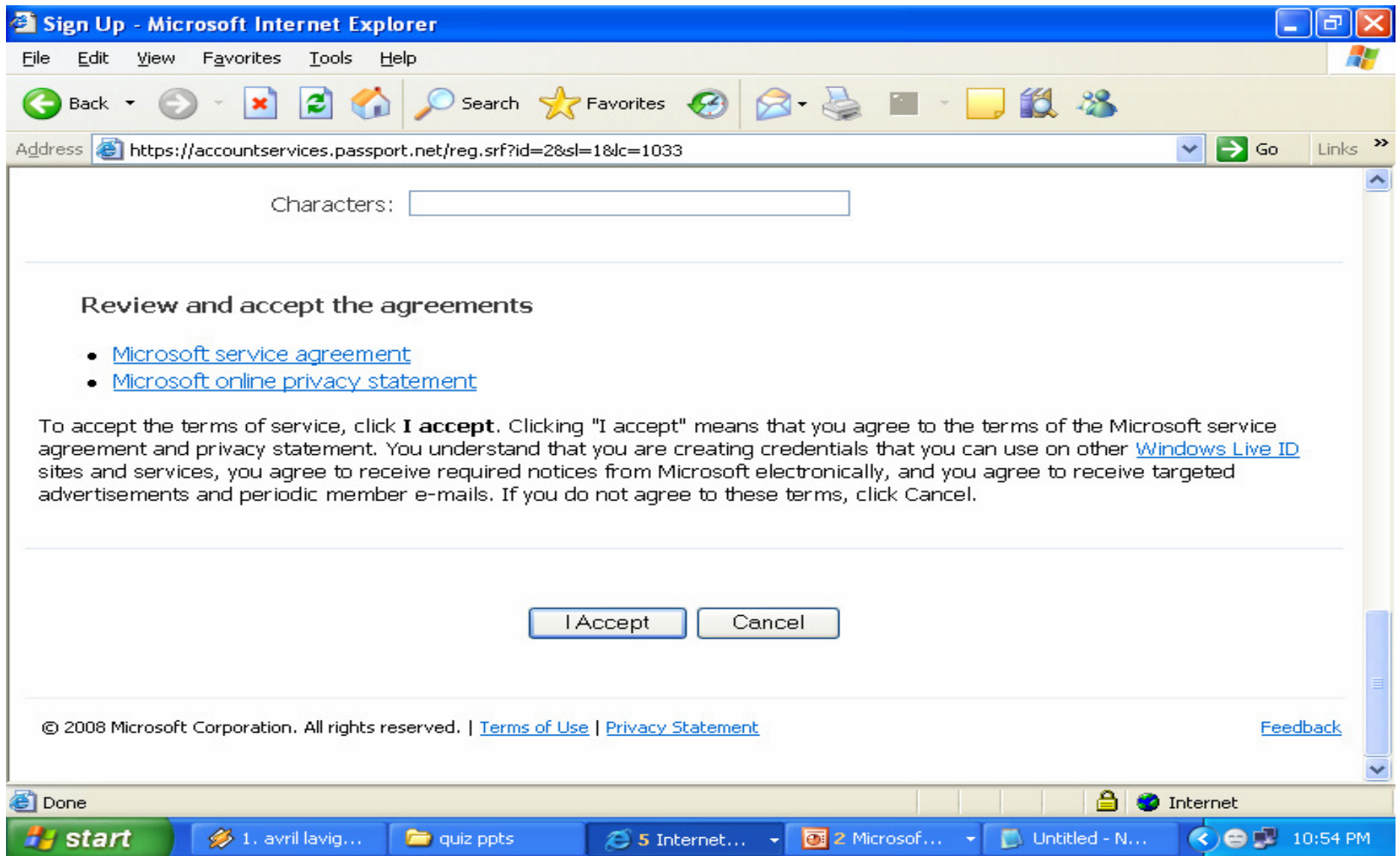

What is this expression?

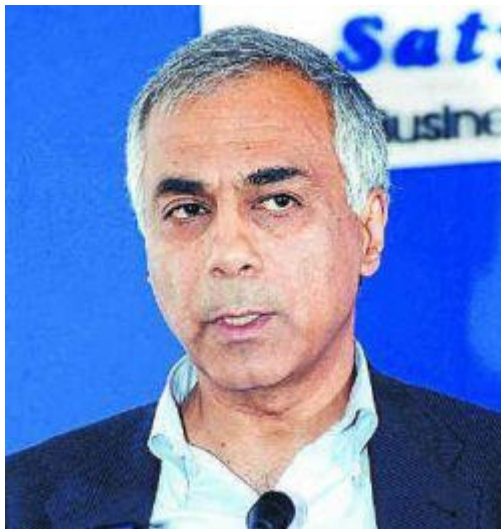
