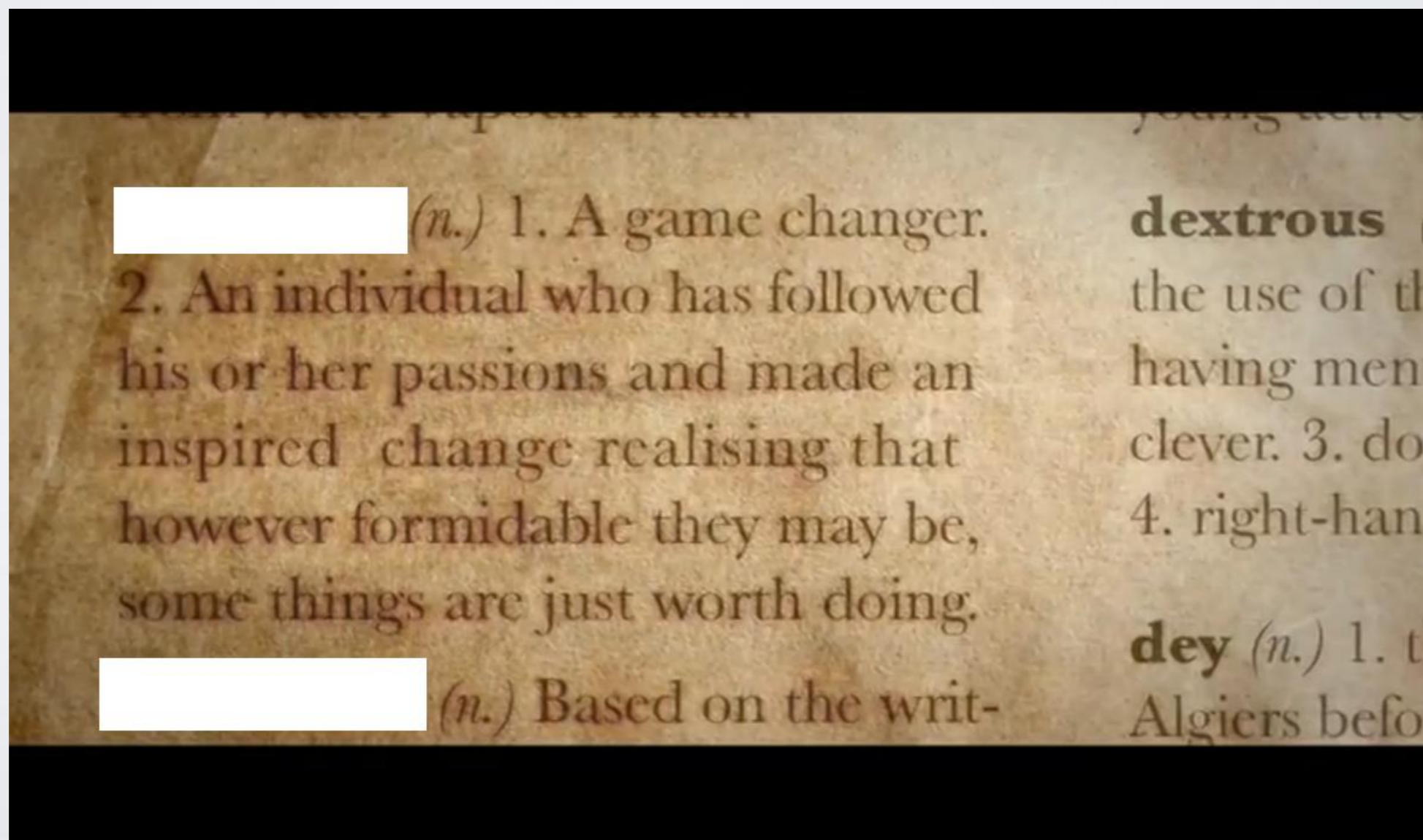
And the answer is...

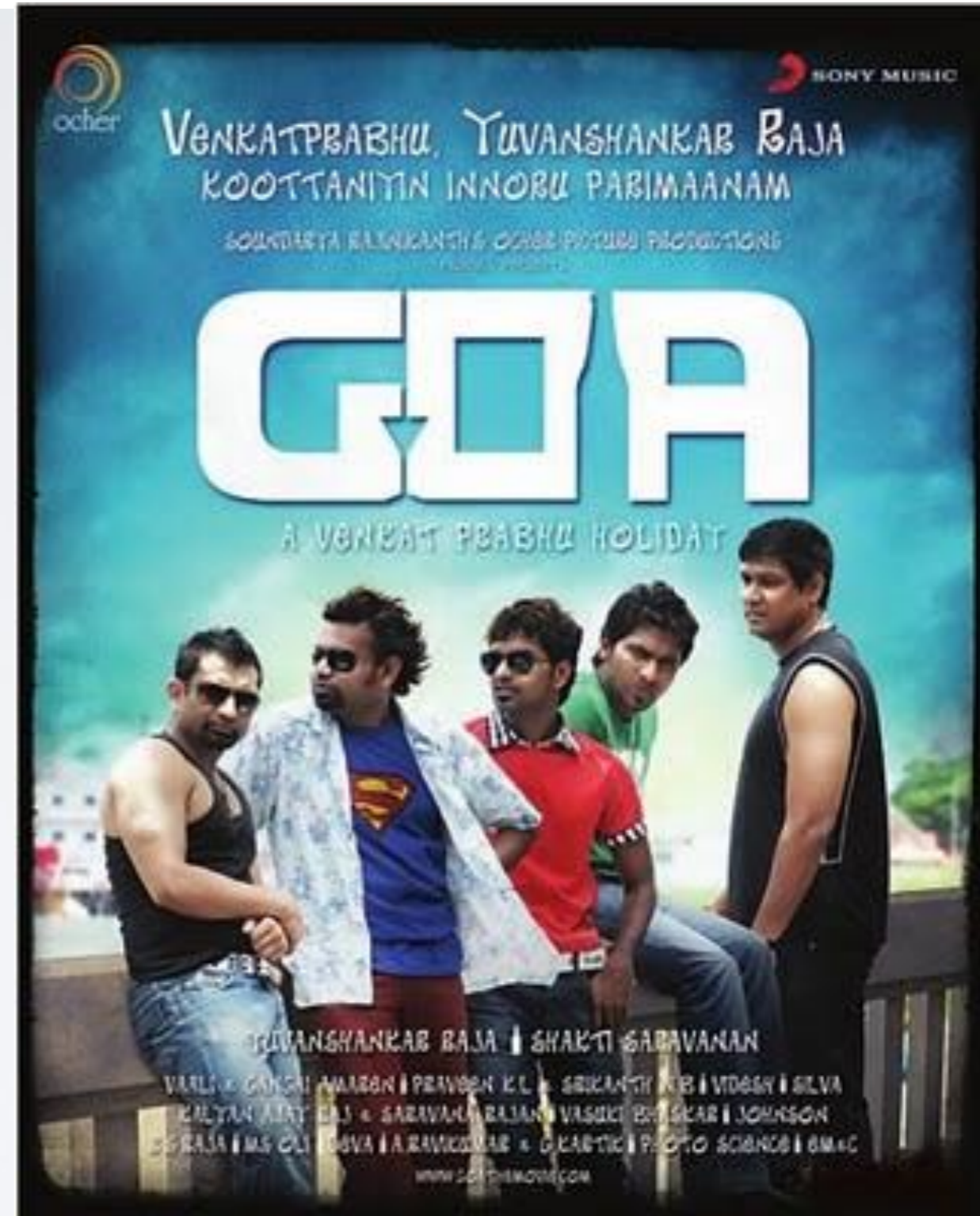
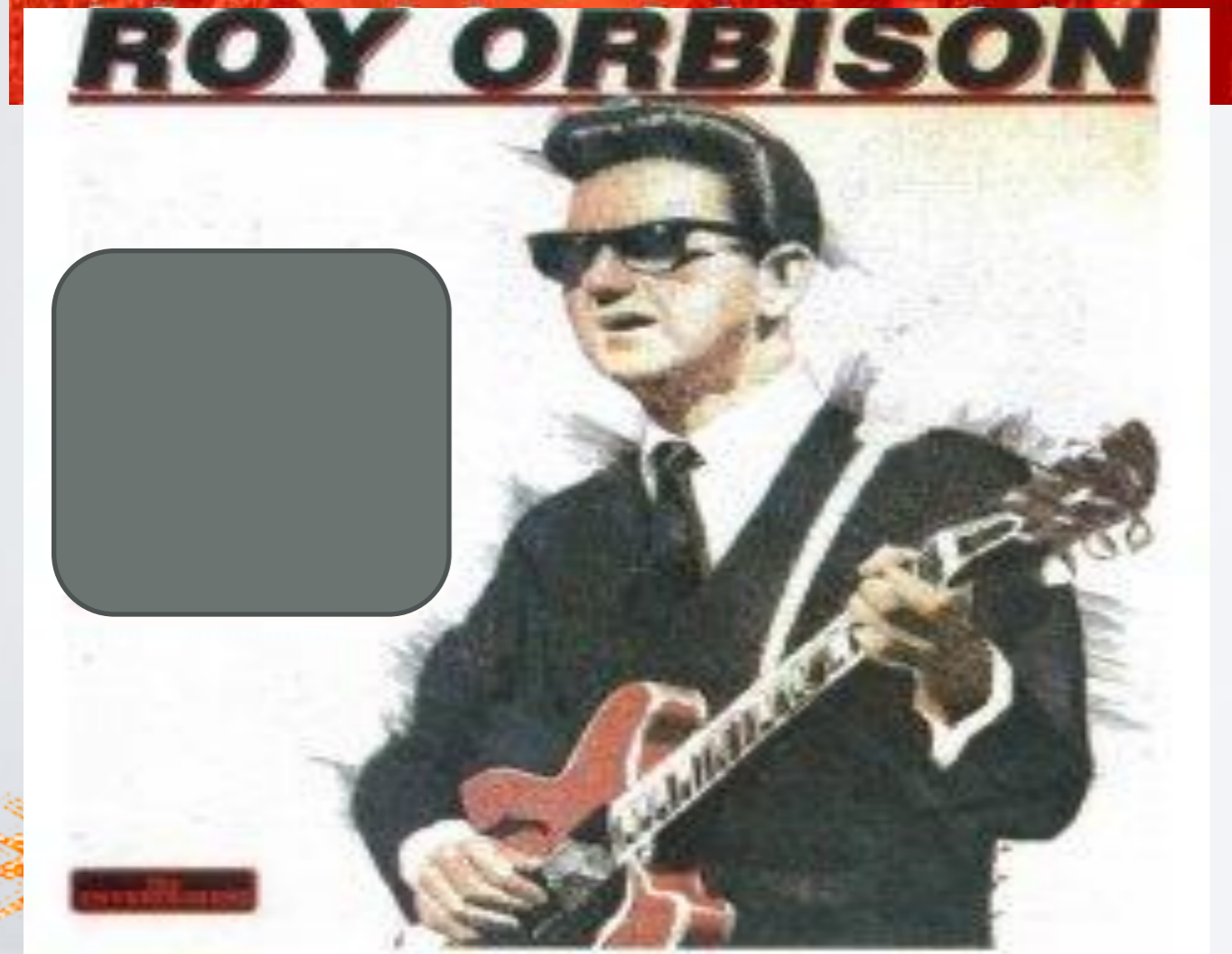
